Boat Classes Offered: 4+, 4x, 2-, 2x and 1x

Additional Boat Classes offered: CRA 8+, Women's CRA 8+, Masters 4-, and Mixed 2x and 4+ in Seniors and Masters.

The CRA 8+ and Women's CRA 8+ event is only open to clubs affiliated to the Cambridgeshire Rowing association. If sufficient entries permit then we will split the 8's competition between Masters and Open in both events – please let us know if you are a masters crew when entering.

If you have any alternative entries that you could do please note it on the additional notes section of BROE2. Crews will only receive a medal if there are two or more entries from separate clubs in an event. Handicaps may be applied to British Rowing Masters events. Refunds will only be given in exceptional circumstances. Once the draw has been compiled and issued, no changes will be made except in exceptional circumstances. Please note that all boats taking part must be licensed with the Environment Agency. Any boats not licensed are liable to be fined by the Environment Agency. It is the responsibility of all competing clubs to ensure that they have the requisite licenses. The British Rowing membership insurance is only valid for UK residents who are resident in this country for more than six months in a year.
